

Figure 1: Final Causal Loop Diagram of Psychosocial Syndemics of Women Living with and At-Risk of HIV/AIDS.






Figure 2: Clinical Profile A.

Woman with no reported history of childhood sexual abuse, moderately high self-worth, non-depressed, low perceived financial hardship, low risk of violence, and no reported drug use.

about figure: All figures present key constructs in our model. Drug use and adult violence are shown to occur at particular moments over a 2-year time horizon. Self-worth, perceived poverty, and sexual self-care are scaled from

0-100 and emotional distress is scaled from 0-60 in accordance with the CESD scale. To facilitate presentation of our results, all four of these constructs are presented on the same scale.

Woman with no reported history of childhood sexual abuse, moderate self-worth, depressed, high perceived financial hardship, moderately low risk of violence, and reported history of drug use and relapse.

Initial Risk of Adult Violence=25



Baseline Perceived Financial Hardship =50




Figure 5: Causal Loop Diagram Depicting Self-worth Balancing Loops.
