VP Membership Report by Özge Pala

There are two issues to report on.

1) Questions from the society's Iranian Members

This issue is supported by VP Chapters Stefano Armenia

Due to the Travel Ban to the United States, Iranian members most probably will not be able to attend the conference this year. They are disappointed and frustrated with the developments. And they would appreciate any support from the society. They have questions regarding the conference and their papers. Their specific questions are as follows:

- If members' VISA applications are rejected:
 - would their paper still be in the proceedings?
 - would their conference registration fee be refunded?
 - is it possible that one of the reviewers can present their research? (in order to collect feedback from the attendees.)
 - If not, would it be possible to allocate a special time and area for these papers to be presented as posters, so that people can write their comments for the authors?
- If the new regulations continue for four more years, will the next conference in 2-yrs time still be in the US?

2) SIG reports.

- In 2016, two new SIGs were recognized by the society: Asset Dynamics and Transportation.
- The name of the Psychology SIG was changed to Psychology and Human Behavior SIG.
- Most SIGs (11/13) submitted a full report (please see the supporting file). You can see a summary of their past activities, planned activities, and support requested in the table below. In general, most SIGs have plans for activities in the coming year.
- Some specific requests for help are as follows:
 - PR for SIG activities, efforts, and products (Asset Dynamics SIG, Business SIG, Agriculture and Food SIG)
 - Assist with networking (to external potential project sponsors) (Biomedical SIG and Agriculture and Food SIG)

- Fund to organize events (Transportation SIG) – They are now informed of the 'Field Development' Fund and might send an application to VP Chapters.
- Support for putting in place a content management system for the webpage – for a WordPress based publication compilation portal to be used (Energy SIG)
- Time and financial support for SD eXchange - Would the Society consider adopting Google Apps for Non Profits? (Business SIG)
- Tools for webinars and i-frames for resource library on the society website (Asset Dynamics SIG) – Purpose is to make the society website a place for knowledge sharing
- Go-To-Meeting license or a similar platform (Agriculture and Food SIG)
- Webinar license or platform (Agriculture and Food SIG)
