What if the academy mattered?



 - DID NOT UNDERSTAND IT!








- 2002

 Forrester!








- 2002

How it is sustained

- Create SD learning opportunities in existing courses
- Create and launch SD courses when new courses are requested/needed
 - Warren Buffett strategy
 be patient but react quickly when the opportunity
 becomes available





How it is sustained

- Create models & access SD tools for the students to use
 - (rather than students building models)
- Final exam/project:
 - Have students specifically reflect on what were the top 3 most interesting learning outcomes?
