The Business SIG was formed after the 2004 International System Dynamics Conference as the direct result of several discussions during that meeting. The purpose of this SIG is essentially to advance the use of system dynamics in business applications. There are many ways to accomplish this, including sharing of best practices within business settings and the sharing of appropriate case studies illustrating the use of and insight gained from system dynamics to address the challenges facing business leaders.

We held our first business meeting at the 2005 ISDC in Boston. The meeting was well-attended by representatives from a cross-section of industries and business consultancies. The time was spent brainstorming activities that the members considered would support the SIG's mission. The discussion produced an extensive list of ideas for further consideration. Several members suggested the use of a group website where relevant information could be shared. Guiding documents and minutes of last year's meeting have been posted along with a membership list with names and contact information.
