Currently, the Chapter is represented in the Policy Council by Gloria Pérez from "Instituto Tecnológico de Monterrey" (Mexico) and presided by Martin Schaffernicht from the "Universidad de Talca" (Chile).

The future

In the short term, priorities are to strengthen the internal structure of the chapter so as to foster collaboration despite the geographical distance between members, and to develop the quality of work presented at the conference and in the review.

In the medium term, there are several challenges to be addressed. System Dynamics is not mainstream in the Spanish speaking world (Latin America and Spain), neither in education nor in business. Much of the material available in English (software, simulations, books) will not penetrate this space unless they are made available in Spanish. There are initiatives ("Evolución", a Spanish SD modelling environment developed by the SIMON group in Colombia; the same groups is undertaking a large collaboration with schools; some firms are translating part of their material; a textbook is in preparation).

Also, the Chapter's mail list falls victim to the international list: many of the practicing dynamicists are able to work in English, when one needs to ask or discuss something, the international list connects you with many more members.

Something similar happens with the "Revista": as a new medium, it does not have the publication value of the ISI "System Dynamics Review", so dynamicists with good work done have a strong incentive to publish in the "Review" rather than in the "Revista".

Designing strategies in order to advance in these domains is an important issue if we are to achieve the Chapter's raison d'être.
