2. **Statistics**

Various reports can be run in *Manuscript Central* and three of these are included as appendices. Appendix 1 gives Days to Decision (for papers that have reached a decision) and Appendix 2 gives the split of the outcome for each paper, including those still in review.

Those in review number 24 and are at various stages of the editorial process. Unfortunately a number of these are still undecided after more than 6 months. This has arisen from a combination of reviewer/editor tardiness. Hopefully the Phase 2 implementation referred to below will result in referees responding within a reasonable time.

3. *Manuscript Central*

We have had one year's experience with MC and all seems to be operating smoothly. But now we are taking a step up. We are moving to Phase 2 of the MC system whereby the entire process of peer review and decision making is handled online. At present Managing Editors have to select the referees and communicate with them directly. The Phase 2 system will, *inter alia*, allow online selection (from a growing database) and automatically fire off reminder emails at set points in the process.

4. Special Issues


A CfP on an Information Systems Special Issue appeared in SDR with a deadline for initial responses in June 2007.

5. Editorial Board members


Krys Stave (University of Nevada, Las Vegas) has accepted my invitation to join the slate of Associate Editors.
