# Report VP Meetings, Policy Council Meeting Spring 2008

## 2008 Athens

There have been quite some negotiation with the hotel concerning room rates and meeting space, Roberta knows more about this. I fear, the bottom line is that room rates stay rather high (165 EUR for a double room including breakfast), in particular if the unfortunate exchange rate between USD and EUR is considered.

The local team is trying to attract sponsorship for the conference. There were quite confident to raise a substantial amount of money, but I don't know about any actual numbers.

Roberta is negotiating with the hotel directly about rooms and meeting space. She also tries to establish regular contact with the local organizers, which seems to be a bit difficult sometimes. See her report on the website.

## 2009 Albuquerque

Smooth organization of the event, so far. It seems that Len Malczynski and Aldo Zagonel from Los Alamos National Labs are in control of the process.
