PREPARATIONS FOR THE ISDC 2008 ATHENS, GREECE JANUARY 2008

This text is a short report on the preparations for the 2008 International System Dynamics Conference in Athens, Greece.

REGISTRATION AND ACCOMMODATION: The registration brochure has been mailed. The registration fee for the conference is set at \$450, which is \$25 higher than the last few years. (Our first registration was received on December 26, 2007!)

A contract has been signed with the InterContinental Hotel. Hotel room reservations will be arranged through the InterContinental Hotel directly. An accommodations booking form will be included with the registration brochure. All rooms include taxes and a full breakfast. Single rooms are $\bigcirc 155$, doubles are $\bigcirc 165$, and triples are $\bigcirc 195$. There are 40 reduced price rooms for students at $\bigcirc 120$, $\bigcirc 130$, and $\bigcirc 160$.

PRECONFERENCE PLANNING: A trip to the InterContinental Hotel may be scheduled for early April in conjunction with the annual Wiley meeting trip.

CONFERENCE BUDGET: The original budget price of 25,000 for meeting rooms and coffee could not be negotiated. Meeting rooms will cost 20,700 and coffee/snack will be served for \oiint each. This brings the budget to a break-even. But, the budget allows for \$60,000 in sponsorship and we currently have only \$27,000.

Personal expenses will be higher than proposed as the hotel room price is ≤ 155 (~ ≤ 227 rather than the proposed was ≤ 150). Additionally the exchange rate for US dollars is low.
