- 1. Main events and achievements of 2016
  - Formed 5 student led peer mentoring groups:
    - o Focus on supporting supporting students with varying levels of expertise
    - o Focus on overcoming SD learning obstacles
    - o Sharing of resources and knowledge bases
  - Initiation of a pilot program where senior SD practitioners join student groups
    - o Pilot program limited to Spring Semester 2017
    - o Identified and addressed senior practitioners concerns of taking on new students, possible conflicts with current advisors, time committment
    - Senior SD practitioners provide additional expert feedback, bridging SD expertise divide

## 2. Main aims for 2017

- Increase number of student led peer mentoring groups
