ISDC 2022 – Frankfurt am Main, Germany "The smallest metropolis in the world"

STATEMENT OF INTENT

Researchers at Frankfurt School of Finance & Management in partnership with the German Chapter of the System Dynamics Society (Deutsche Gesellschaft für System Dynamics e.V.), and universities and businesses established in Germany, are enthused with the idea of bringing the 40th International Conference of The System Dynamics Society to Frankfurt am Main, Germany.

Frankfurt am Main, located in the middle of Germany, with the biggest German airport nearby, constitutes an attractive option for this annual meeting. Holding the International System Dynamics Conference in this region presents an important opportunity for reinforcing and making grow, both in quality and impact, the use of System Dynamics at academic institutions and businesses in Germany.

System Dynamics (SD) modeling in Germany is maturing but looking back at a long tradition. Already at the end of the 1960s, system dynamics started being used at Mannheim University, initiated by Gert v. Kortzfleisch. Peter Milling and Erich Zahn, two doctoral students of this university, joined the "limits to growth" group at MIT in the early 1970s. In 1989, the so far only International System Dynamics Conference in Germany was held in Stuttgart. Nowadays, there is an active German SD chapter (with more than 100 members) holding an annual SD meeting. System Dynamics is taught at more than a dozen German universities, for instance Frankfurt School, University of Stuttgart, etc.

STATEMENT OF UNIQUENESS & ATTRACTIVENESS

Frankfurt am Main is the most international city in Germany, the largest financial center on the continent, the historical city of coronations, the city of Johann Wolfgang von Goethe and the cradle of the German democracy... In brief, the smallest metropolis in the world, in which there is a lot to discover.



Almost one in three of the people living in Frankfurt do not hold a German passport. No matter where visitors come from, they will always meet people in Frankfurt who speak their language and a restaurant that serves their favorite food. The open and hospitable atmosphere in Frankfurt stems from its centuries-old role as a trading center. This liberal and democratic tradition of the city may be one reason for the fact that people from diverse cultures have lived here in peace with one another for a long time. They have all contributed to making this city shine slightly differently from every angle.

This starts with the city's architecture. Those who go and have a drink in a cozy cider pub on a nice summer evening will experience the atmosphere that even Frankfurt's most famous son, Johann Wolfgang von Goethe, would still easily recognize. The view of Frankfurt's bold high-rise architecture is just as attractive and yet very different. Directly opposite the high-rise buildings, on the other side of the Main, a unique collection of 13 museums has been developed and these are devoted to different works of art, from classical paintings to modern media.

The chosen venue for the conference, the Campus of Frankfurt School at Adickesallee is centrally located in Frankfurt's Nordend and is part of the "Campusmeile" that connects Frankfurt's universities and libraries. The Danish office Henning Larsen Architects has designed the campus making it an architectural highlight in the city. It is less than 20 km (about 30 min) from the airport and about 5 km from Frankfurt's main train station, which is the central hub of the German railway system.




EXCELLENT INFRASTRUCTURE FOR OUTSTANDING EVENTS





ARRIVAL AND PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Thanks to its location at the heart of Europe and Germany, Frankfurt is an important traffic hub and can be reached by visitors extremely easily by airplane, by train, and by car and bus.

This is where Europe's second largest airport, with more than 50 million passengers a year, and also the train station in Germany with the highest volume of traffic are situated. Every day, around 350,000 passengers from home and abroad use the central station for their journey from and to Frankfurt. The motorway connection via the Frankfurt interchange also offers a good way of getting here.

Frankfurt Card

An attractive alternative to single tickets or day tickets is the Frankfurt Card. The Frankfurt Card is available as a 1-day or 2-day ticket. Valid for as many journeys as required on all RMV services in fare zone 50 including the airport. It includes reduced admission to many museums and events, for example:

- 20% reduction on Hop on-Hop off sightseeing tours, daily city walks and weekend theme walks around Frankfurt am Main
- 50% reduction on admission to museums in Frankfurt, the Palm Garden and the Zoo.
- 20% reduction on scheduled pleasure river cruises
- Free drinks, discount and gifts at restaurants and in shops

The 1-day ticket is valid on the day entered on the ticket up until close of operations. The 2-day ticket is valid on the day entered on the ticket and the following day up until close of operations.
