

Strengthening the Field Fund (StFF) Discussion

Strengthening the Field Committee:

VP Chapters & SIGs (Stefano Armenia), VP Finance (Eliot Rich), VP Meetings (Sara Metcalf), and VP Membership (Asmeret Naugle)

StFF Guidelines need to be updated

- Clarify criteria, process, and scope
- Establish cycle for considering proposals

The StFC proposes a broader charter

- Beyond Chapter & SIG focus
- Expand variety of potential projects
- o Collaborate efficiently with Home Office

Purpose of the StFF: Provide funding for activities designed to promote the growth of the System Dynamics field

Funding proposals can be submitted by <u>all</u> Society members, including representatives of Chapters and SIGs

- Funding should be used for activities/purposes that appeal to a broad base of Society members, and potentially a broader audience outside of the Society
- Any funded activities should be available to *all* Society members

Strengthening the Field Fund (StFF) Discussion

Goals of the StFF (and criteria on which proposals are judged):

- Increase membership of the System Dynamics Society
- Improve members' capabilities in System Dynamics
- Enable knowledge sharing and dissemination on SD topics
- Facilitate community building and collaboration among members
- Support interest and enthusiasm around SD topics
- Make it easier for people to learn and share experiences
- Facilitate chapter and SIG activities
- Improve linkages to other professional or academic societies

StFF resources shall NOT be used:

- To duplicate existing resources and/or activities
- To overlap with outreach efforts of the Home Office
- primarily for marketing of SD
