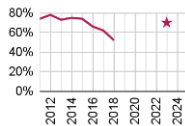

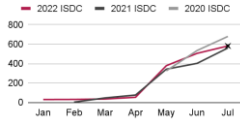
### Monthly Membership Evolution



### Retention rate

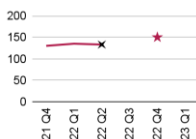

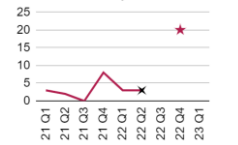

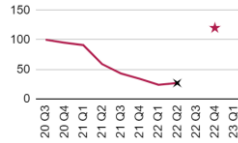

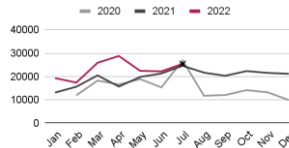

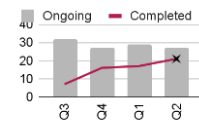

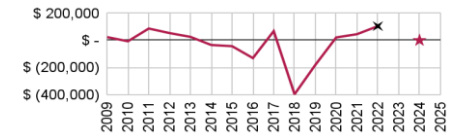

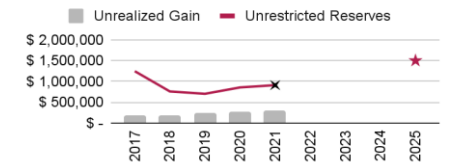

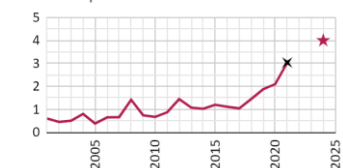

Motion to plan future International System Dynamics Conferences using a Hybrid in-person/virtual model with an in-person capacity limit determined at the discretion of VP meetings with reduced-cost virtual attendance options.

- Default **plan** is 260 in-person
- Place **limit** on in-person registrations of
  - MIN(sum of the parallel room capacity, plenary room capacity)  $\approx$  350
  - Reduced physical capacity - assumed @ 5-7 parallel rooms
- Before April 1st if registration is close to or exceeds **plan** renegotiate contracts with new revenue expectations capping at **limit**.
- If **plan** is exceeded after April 1st offer virtual registrations
