



Dashboard of SDS Objectives and Key Results (WIP)










Price to rise in January to allow autorenews to happen at lower price

Reminder about approved dues motion from 2020

That a single dues structure be adopted for all individual System Dynamics Society members, with special dispensation allowed for students, recent students, those applying for financial support, and individuals living in lower-income and lower-middleincome tier countries as classified by the World Bank. Annual dues will be set between US\$120 and US\$225 per year, with discounted membership rates between 15% and 50% of the chosen rate. The actual dues schedule will be determined by the Executive Director in consultation with the VP Membership and VP Finance, and will be adjusted periodically to reflect inflation. Access to the printed version of the System Dynamics Review will be charged in addition to dues at a price that covers the Society's delivered cost. This change will take effect beginning in 2021.




