


On behalf of the Finance Committee, I move to adjust the 2023 Operating Budget to include an additional \$10,000 to pay for a retrospective audit of FY 2021.



Dashboard of SDS Objectives and Key Results (WIP)




Dashboard of SDS Objectives and Key Results (WIP)
